- 1 Terry keeps saying “you can’t be a follower of Jesus unless you’re actually following Jesus”.
- 2 Why do you think he thinks this is so important to repeat?
- 3 What does “actually following Jesus” look like in your life?
- 4 What examples can you think of — especially in your own life — where “the follower of Jesus” seems to be confused about what that is or looks like?
- 5 Read the parable of the Good Samaritan, in Luke 10:25-37 (notice the guy got mugged along “the way”. Which also means this was along the Samaritan’s way, and along every other person’s way too.)
  - 1 Who might these people be today?
  - 2 What if the injured person were someone from a different ethnic group than yours? Would you stop to help?
  - 3 Why do you think the two Jews walked away from him?
  - 4 Why was it so unusual for the Samaritan to stop and tend to the man's wounds? In what ways is his situation like ours?
  - 5 What if the injured man was a Palestinian? A Muslim? An Iraqi?
  - 6 What did the lawyer learn from this parable?
