• **HAGGAI 2:6-7** ⁶ "This is what the Lord Almighty says: 'In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. ⁷ I will shake all nations, and the desired of all nations will come, and I will fill this house with glory,' says the Lord Almighty. • **REVELATION 21:24** The nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their splendor into it.

• **HEBREWS 1:2** but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. • **HEBREWS 1:6** And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him." • **REVELATION 5:13** Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!" • **GALATIANS 4:4** But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, • **LUKE 1:34** "How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?" • **LUKE 2:9-17** ⁹ An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. ¹⁰ But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. - **COLOSSIANS 2:9** For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form,

- **MATTHEW 1:23** “The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel”-- which means, “God with us.” • **JOHN 1:14** The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. • **COLOSSIANS 1:15** He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

- **ISAIAH 9:6-7**⁶ For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. He will reign on David’s throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the Lord Almighty will accomplish this. • **MALACHI 4:2** But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings. And you will go out and leap like calves released from the stall.
- **REVELATION 21:23** The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp. • **2 TIMOTHY 1:10** [The grace of God] has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

- **JOHN 3:16** “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. • **JOHN 11:25-26**²⁵ Jesus says, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies;²⁶ and whoever lives and believes in me will never die.

- **JOHN 6:54** Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.

- **1 PETER 1:23-25**²³ For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.²⁴ For, “All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall,²⁵ but the word of the Lord stands forever.” And this is the word that was preached to you. • **JOHN 3:3-6**³ Jesus declared, “I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again.”⁴ “How can a man be born when he is old?” Nicodemus asked. “Surely he cannot enter a second time into his mother’s womb to be born!”⁵ Jesus answered, “I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit.⁶ Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.
