Luke 4:31-44

① → Jesus' words were spoken (v32) with conviction and authority, compared to the scribes who often spoke in the synagogue.

① What was the source of Jesus' conviction and authority? Was it His divinity, or something else?

② Should we expect conviction and authority to be active in our own teaching today? Why or why not?

② → How did Jesus treat the sick people he encountered that afternoon and evening in Capernaum? What kind of example does that set for us to follow?

③ → Which was the more important motivator for Jesus: compassion or duty? Did they ever conflict?

④ → In verse 42 is Jesus having what we call a Quiet Time? Is that all He was doing? Is there something greater than a 'Quiet Time' for church today?
