1 → Jesus is sending. Why does that make a difference?

2 → If it's true that their/our defenselessness would cause every one of us to be all the more dependent upon God... What is different in our lives because of it? What's different in our living since last Sunday, or last Thursday when we first heard this reiterated?

Use these questions to further explore and discuss:

3 → Am I living my life or Jesus life? (How do you know? What's the difference?)

4 → Am I complaining about my life, or Jesus life? (How do you know? What's the difference?)

5 → Am I thinking I should have my life or Jesus life? (How do you know? What's the difference?)

6 → Am I planning my life or looking to Jesus for His life? (How do you know? What's the difference?)

8 → **Extra credit discussion from our Thursday study in chapter 10:** Luke 10:4 Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; **and do not greet anyone on the road.**
