① In our lives in Christ, doubts should lead to questions, then to answers, and then on to accepted answers...

② Thomas was seemingly corrected for needing to see in order to believe, not for having doubts (John 20:27 Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe.")

③ Mark 9:23-25 ²³ "If you can?" said Jesus. "Everything is possible for him who believes." ²⁴ Immediately the boy's father exclaimed, "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" ²⁵ When Jesus saw that a crowd was running to the scene, he rebuked the evil spirit. "You deaf and mute spirit," he said, "I command you, come out of him and never enter him again."
